Please take the time to follow us, like and share Trailblazers' experiences and learn how we can empower our BRAVE YOUNG PEOPLE!


### Methods of Liberation:

Our TWP is flourishing!!!


Parents, thank you for your involvement with parent workshops, family nights, and our first ever Virtual Retreat!

This month, the BRAVE Team hosted our very first BRAVE Trailblazers Virtual Retreat!!! It was a weekend full of family workshops, parent workshops, student workshops, food, and fun!!!

On Saturday, March 20th, families engaged in a workshop with Rev. Terrence Proctor on "Standing Firm on Family Values". Both students and parents identified what values are most important to them as individuals. Later, each family shared their values and selected 4 family pillars and decorated a family poster!

After lunch, parents attended a powerful workshop with Mr. Dion Schell on "College and Career Readiness" where he dropped some MAJOR GEMS! Stay tuned as we bring him back for more!!!

Students learned how to use their voices to fight for what THEY want to see in school curriculum with Ms. Tierra Johnson in her "What I Want to Learn vs. What School Teaches" workshop!



On Sunday, March 21st, families engaged in a workshop with Ms. Ismalis Nuñez on "The Importance of Self-Identity in Social Justice work". Both students and parents engaged in Courageous Conversations About Race, exploring their identities and how we authentically show up. Together we explored what it means to see things from multiple perspectives and analyzed the social construction of race.

Later, each member of the family went for a mini-scavenger hunt to find a small item that represents them and place it, along with I-AM poems in their family jars!!! Students and parents shared POWERFUL "I Am" poems!
